

Mendoza's Wineries and Olive Trees

We will visit two wineries in the districts of Maipú and Luján de Cuyo. The first part of this guided tour ends with a delicious wine tasting. Mendoza also has a thriving olive oil industry. During the second part of the tour we will visit an olive oil production facility to find out everything about this internationally acclaimed product.

The Magic of Wine

We will leave in the morning to the district of Maipú, where we will visit Bodega López, a family-owned winery and one of the oldest to be actively involved in wine-making in Mendoza. After that, we will visit Bodega El Enemigo, one of the top award-winning wineries in Mendoza, located in the area known as Chachingo. Guests will enjoy lunch at Casa Vigil, the wineries' restaurant, which serves superb local cuisine accompanied by the delicious wines of internationally acclaimed winemaker Alejandro Vigil.

Mendoza City Tour

Tour highlights include Área Fundacional, the historical site where the old city of Mendoza was first founded and then destroyed by the 1861 Earthquake; downtown Mendoza, including Mendoza's five emblematic squares and civic center; a tour around General San Martín Park, including Cerro de la Gloria (the hill in the West end of the park), the artificial lake, the Continentes Fountain, the stadium and the Olympic villa.

Total tour distance: 40 miles *half-day afternoon tour.



Mendoza, and The Andes

A breathtaking tour to the highest mountains of our province. We will drive Route 82 through the Cacheuta road tunnel and then Route 7 (the route to Chile). Tour highlights include Potrerillos Dike, Potrerillos village, Uspallata village, the historical bridge of Picheuta, Punta de Vacas, Los Penitentes ski resort, Puente del Inca (a natural arch that forms a bridge over a mountain river), the Aconcagua lookout (Aconcagua is the highest mountain in the Americas). We will have lunch at a restaurant in the mountains (lunch not included in tour price). The last stop of the tour is Las Cuevas, the mountain village located just before the border with Chile.

San Rafael, The Atuel Canyon and Valle Grande

The tour starts early in the morning. We will drive South along Route 40 for 150 miles. After a short visit to the city of San Rafael, we will drive West along Route 40 to the dike and the village known as El Nihuil. Here, we will start our way down the Atuel Canyon, a natural canyon formed by the action of wind and water from the Atuel River. The canyon ends in the valley known as Valle Grande (great valley), which hosts another dam for hydroelectric power generation. We will stop for lunch in Los Nihuiles (lunch is not included).

Total tour distance: 400 miles

Mendoza and Villavicencio Natural Reserve

We will leave the city and follow old Route 40 to the North.

After the Canota monument (which commemorates the site where the liberating army divided into columns before crossing the Andes on its way to liberate Chile) we will arrive in Pampa de Canota and then drive pass the famous bottling facilities. Finally, we will arrive in Villavicencio, a natural reserve that hosts the beautiful gardens of the old Villavicencio Hot Springs Hotel—the emblematic hotel featured in the label of Villavicencio™ mineral water—and a splendid viewpoint of the area.

Total tour distance: 62 miles.

Mendoza - Relax and Spa Tour -Cacheuta Hot Springs

We will follow Route 82 through the Cacheuta tunnel. Cacheuta Hot Springs Hotel and Spa is located at the foot of the Andes on the banks of the Mendoza River. Guests can relax in the many indoor and outdoor pools (water temperatures range between 86°F and 104°F) and enjoy the different spa treatments and services (i.e. hot spring pools, showers, mud pools, steam rooms, etc.). After a delicious traditional lunch, guests can continue to the enjoy the spa during the afternoon.

Total tour distance: 25 miles
